Evaluation Methods Used: Testing for Cambium TIDE System involved a combination of manual and functional testing. Level Access (Level) comprehensively tested a selection of pages representative of the Cambium TIDE System with the screen reader JAWS 2021, exclusive use of the keyboard, and manual inspection of code and Accessibility API output. Level also functionally tested several user flows of the Cambium TIDE System with JAWS 2021.
