ClearSight Assessment, Helping to Close the COVID Gap: A Strategy for Summer Programs

Students have faced multiple challenges during this school year. Opportunities in the summer may provide extra instructional time for students. For a teacher, the best way to start is to gain information about students' mastery of state standards. This enables the educator to identify a starting point for targeted instruction. *ClearSight* can quickly, in one class period or less, provide valid and reliable data to help educators identify current standard mastery, whether on or off grade level, and monitor progress during summer programs.



Using *ClearSight* Interim Assessments

Educators can administer *ClearSight* Interim Assessments at the start of summer programs to see a student's current mastery of standards. At the end of summer programs a second administration of the Interim can be given and reports showing the student's changes in learning can be viewed. The example below shows a four-month period of instruction. Though a summer program would only reflect 4-6 weeks of instruction, the different Interim results will be similarly available.



Using ClearSight Checkpoint Assessments

Between the Interim administrations, Checkpoints can be used to provide more detailed standards-level data for Mathematics and English Language Arts topics. These are short tests that take 30 minutes or less to administer. There are 3 forms for each topic per grade so they can be used as pre/posttests, quick quizzes, or checks for understanding during this instructional period.

Flexible Administration


All assessments can be administered as supervised tests or independent assignments. Also, you can administer in person, remotely, or both at the same time.

ClearSight provides longitudinal reports to help track student growth across multiple related assessments or across multiple test opportunities of a single assessment. Educators can see how performance improved for a student or group of students across grades or within a grade. These reports are available immediately after testing is completed.
